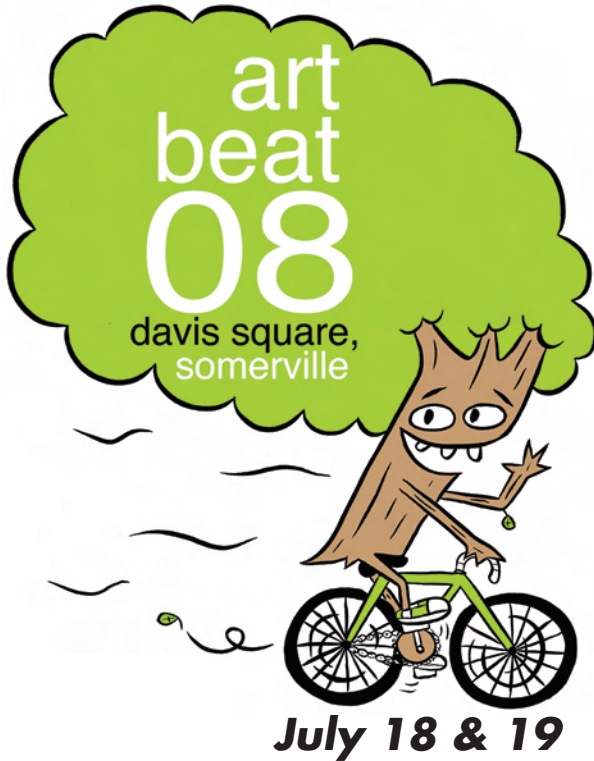


Mayor Joseph A. Curtatone and the Somerville Arts Council invite you to...
