We seek short (under 2 minutes) CAT-themed videos—produced here in Somerville or from around the world. Awards will be given to local filmmakers for different CATegories: weirdest, cutest, etc. We welcome all genres: documentary, narrative, experimental, animated, etc. Individuals may submit up to 3 separate entries. Filmmakers also can elect to broadcast their submission on Somerville Community Access Television.

Preferably send us link to where you have uploaded video or send us a standard DVD or Quicktime data DVD (Copy Cat Fest/ SCATV, 90 Union Square, Somerville, MA 02143). Quicktime compatible video files may be submitted via wetransfer.com. DVD submissions will not be returned.
